# Keats & 'Negative Capability'

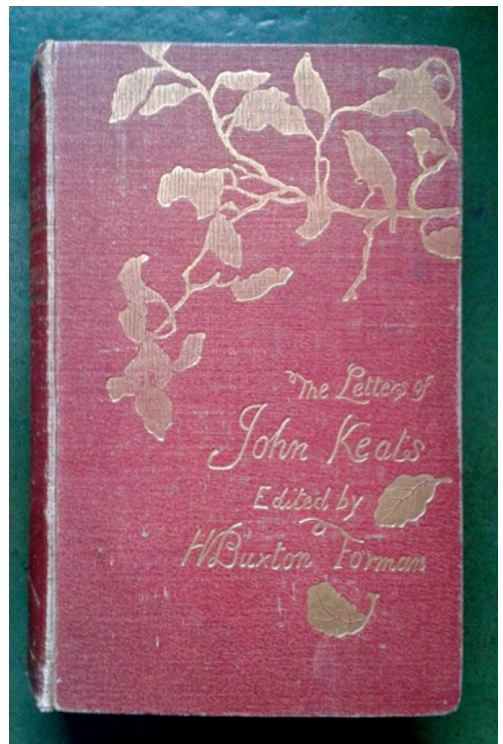
